Received my license from Washington state through the CPM Plus Bridge Program 1991 I relocated to Spokane and have worked at the Spokane Birth Clinic and with Margaret Lipton CNM during this time I also ran my own practice., I am current with my national Certification CPM and licensure from Washington state. At this time I have attended over 1,000 births. I offer labor, delivery and post partum midwifery services, complete midwifery maternity care for women throughout their childbearing year; pre-conception, pregnancy, birth and postpartum care.

#### Post partum care includes

1. 24 hour visit with exam for mom and newborn (includes Newborn Screening, and Pulse ox screening) In your home (Baby needs to see a Pediatrician during 3rd week of life)

- 2. 3-4 day visit if indicated with exam for mom and newborn in your home.
- 3. 3 week visit with exam of mom and newborn (in office)
- 6-8 week visit with exam for mom including pap and family planning consultation with newborn exam (in office)
- 5. Breastfeeding instruction and guidance
- 6. Blood Glucose Screening if appropriate
- 7. Hct & Hgb Screening
- 8. PAP Screening if desired

I often ask the children to hold the measuring tape, use the Doppler, or inflate the blood pressure cuff during prenatal visits.
